- C. Fire- Chief Babcock reported 14 Calls for the month in Bangor Township with the Year to Date at 509. The Bangor Grass rig is being used for training in Benton Harbor for the new fire fighters. Brandon Brown was awarded Fire Fighter of the year and new online training will begin in 2023.**
- D. Sheriff- Torres gave reports for October and November. Has been working on Blight letters to create better communication with residents to improve their properties and so far they have proven effective.**
- E. Pride Care- Mike Sullins reported in place of Steve Lowder, that there were 17 calls for the month of November with an average response time of 6:09 minutes. There were 5 priority one calls, 10 priority two calls, and 2 priority three calls.**
- F. County Commissioner- Mike Chappel reported the County Commissioners signed an agreement to purchase the Kelly Page building at 203 S Niles St Paw Paw which will be used for Friend of the Court Offices. Land Management is being relocated to GIS and are looking for a GIS Director. The Administration office has been relocated to the old Veterans Services suite. Reginald Boze has been reappointed to the VBC Road Commission.**
- G. Road Commission- W.C. Askew reported there was a pipe instal east of 681 in Bangor Township, Deburming is coming soon and Patching, Boom mowing and tree removal has been ongoing.**
- H. Supervisors Report- Sullins reported that he attended the VBCRoad Commission meeting and confirmed that Bangor Township roads are on their 5 year plan.**
