- C. Sheriff- Deputy Torres reported 44 calls for the Month of January. He recommends the township offer more trash and recycling or spread the word about what the Township does offer to avoid so much dumping of tires and garbage.**

- D. Fire- Chief Babcock reported 28 calls for the Month of January, of those calls one of them was a lawn mower fire. The Annual ABB Fire Board meeting will be March 29th at 7:00pm at the Bangor Fire Hall. A new training facility will be built behind the Bangor Fire Hall soon. Babcock also presented the Fire Departments Annual report for 2022. The Bangor Public School District will have a Bond proposal on the May 2nd Ballot which is a “No Increase Bond”.**

- E. Pride Care- Steve Lowder reported that there were 36 calls for the month of January with an average response time of 6:01 minutes. There were 15 priority one calls, 19 priority two calls, and 2 priority three calls.**

- F. Road Commission- W.C. Askew reported that as of February 28th Dan Bishop will no longer be working for the Road Commission and his replacement will be Brett Witkowski on March 6th. February 23rd at 7:00pm will be the Supervisors Meeting. Askew gives the green light for Bangor Township to install Solar light curve signs around the Merriman Lake Curve on CR 687 and encourages the board to bring ideas to the new Director.**

- G. Senior Services- Regina Hoover reported that the quarterly newsletter is available for Seniors in Bangor Township and that Covert has entered a Contract with Senior Services. Suggests the Board put forward an image idea to add to the Mural at the South Haven Location.**
