

Bangor Township February Special Meeting

The Special meeting of the Bangor Township Board was held at the Bangor Township Hall on 2/02/2023 at 4:30 pm. Board members Michael Sullins- Supervisor, Amanda Karr- Clerk, Sandra Karr-Treasurer, David Houdek- Trustee and Regina Hoover- Trustee were present.

Purpose of the Special Meeting was to discuss and/or pass Resolution 2023-02.

Opened meeting at 4:31 pm

A. Michael Sullins made a motion, seconded by David Houdek to sign and approve:

BANGOR TOWNSHIP, VAN BUREN COUNTY RESOLUTION NUMBER 2023-02

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Bangor Township wishes to provide funds for construction and maintenance of township roads; and

WHEREAS, Public Act 39, of 1976, authorizes a local unit of government to appropriate funds for roads; and

WHEREAS, townships may impose and levy ad valorem property taxes to finance lawful public services, as authorized by the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and other laws; and

WHEREAS, the Bangor Township Board wishes to impose a levy of 4 mills to construct and maintain roads in the township;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Bangor Township Board, Van Buren County, Michigan, resolves to submit the follow ballot proposition to the voters in a Special election to be held May, 2023:

Shall the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution, be increased by 4 mills (\$4.00 per \$1000 of taxable value for real and personal property) on all ad valorem taxes within the Township of Bangor for the four (4) year period of 2023 through 2026 (2023, 2024, 2025, and 2026) inclusive for the purpose of appropriating funds for maintenance and construction of roads within the unincorporated portions of the Township of Bangor; and shall the township levy such millage, thereby raising in the first year of levy an estimated \$291,689?
