- C. Sheriff- Deputy Torres reported 43 complaints for the month of June with 16 traffic stops. He has been handing out copies of the Townships new Camper ordinance to help people who are living in campers and has several ongoing blight cases.
- D. Fire Board- Derek Babcock reported that there were 14 calls for the month of June within Bangor Township that brings the year to date calls to 257. The Fire Department's new bay floors and walls are completed. There was a good turn out for the pancake breakfast and the Fireworks display was better than ever. The Department is getting its parking lot resealed and stripped, and is looking at getting a new air compressor. All personnel have taken their yearly DOT physicals and all went well. The Great Lakes Drone company will be assisting with search and rescues.
- E. Pride Care- Steve Lowder reported 20 calls for the month of June with an average response time of 6:23 minutes. There were 10 priority one calls, 8 priority two calls, and 2 priority three calls.
