- C. **Fire Board-** Derek Babcock reported that there were 11 calls for the month of May within Bangor Township. The Fire Department has new flooring inside the bay and are repainting the walls as well. July 2nd from 7-10 am will be the Pancake breakfast. Fireworks will be on July 4th beginning at 10:15pm. The Fire Station serves as a cooling station during these very hot days.
- D. **Pride Care-** Steve Lowder reported 20 calls for the month of May with an average response time of 6:12 minutes. There were 7 priority one calls, 12 priority two calls, and 1 priority three call.
- E. **Road Commission-** Dan Bishop reported that the Road Commission is looking for grant money to redo CR 378. Construction for the new Road Commission garage is scheduled for 2023 due to unavailability of materials. Took complaints: roadside mowing was not conducted in a timely manner.
- F. **County Commissioner-** Mike Chappel reported that commissioners approved the application and strategy for the FY2023 MVAA funds. The Wine & Harvest fest will be at the county park September 9-11. Commissioners approved an agreement with Ottawa County Juvenile Detention Center.
