- C. Sheriff- Deputy Torres reported that there were 29 complaints in the month of May. Would like to move forward with the board's approval on several properties that are violating ordinances.**
- D. Fire Board- Chief Babcock Reported that May was a slow month with only 13 in Bangor Township. Year to date calls are at 245. Monthly CPR classes will be offered to the public starting in July. A large fireworks event is planned for July 4th, thank you to all the Entities who contribute to that fund. Beginning on July 1st Van Buren Emergency Medical Services plans to be taking over for Pride Care in Bangor Township, however, this change may occur as soon as this Friday.**
- E. County Commissioner- Mike Chappel gave a report on the Hazen Street Road Extension, the Animal Control building, the MVA Grant request and that the Brownfield Redevelopment Authority reappointed Zach Morris and Kate Strohauser to their board.**
- F. Pride Care- Steve Lowder reported that there were 28 calls for the month of May with an average response time of 6:17 minutes. The types of calls were 11 priority One calls, 13 priority Two calls, and 4 priority Three calls. Steve also addressed a complaint with the Township Board.**
- G. Supervisors Report- Mike Sullins reported that all the tires at the Transfer station have been removed. Matt with the Van Buren County Jail Crew has been an asset to the Township and they have been cleaning up much of the debris and tires dumped around the Township.**
- H. Road Commission- W.C. Askew reported that the County is not putting up a Bond for their new building on M-43. They would rather fix roads than get a new building. Deburming and Dust control have been ongoing and seal coat begins after July 4th.**
