- C. Sheriff- Sergeant Graham reported 9 complaints and citations for the month of October. Reports that Deputy Torres has been diligent in traffic stops.
- D. Pride Care- Amanda Karr reported in place of Steve Lowder, that there were 22 calls for the month of October with an average response time of 7:06 minutes. There were 6 priority one calls, 8 priority two calls, and 8 priority three call.
- E. County Commissioner- Mike Chappel reported the County Commissioners approved Ryan Post as the new County Administrator and Wayne Nelson was appointed as Road Commissioner. The board approved a request for funding to the Daily Recovery Zone in the amount of \$25,160.00. A County Wide PACE program is being established.
- F. Road Commission- W.C. Askew reported that Bangor Township is on the new five year plan and the meeting about the plan will be held on December 6th at 6:00pm at the Lawrence garage. The Road commission has been deburming around guard rails. Askew says in response to a complaint made that the Township has not been allowed to purchase blinking traffic signs in the past that the Township may purchase them.
- G. Supervisors Report- Amanda Karr reported in Sullins place that all but three tires are removed from the Transfer station.

IV. New Business

- A. The Board discussed interviewing both candidates for the Trustee position.
- B. Motion to open a 12 month CD with Consumers credit union with \$125,000.00 at 4.25% Interest. The account must have three signers who will be, Dave Houdek, Sandra Karr and Amanda Karr. The account must have two signatures on any changes.
