- D. Fire Board- Derek Babcock reported that there were 9 calls for the month of September within Bangor Township that brings the year to date calls to 409. The Fire Board has purchased an extractor to wash gear. Radio reprogramming took place last Thursday and there are two new Firefighters on the roster. October is Fire Prevention month and Derek will be giving presentations at the local schools.**
- E. Pride Care- Mike Sullins in place of Steve Lowder reported 13 calls for the month of September with an average response time of 7:28 minutes. There were 8 priority one calls, 4 priority two calls, and 1 priority three call.**
- F. County Commissioner- Mike Chappel reported the County Commissioners approved the final budget for all funds for the 2022-2023 fiscal year. There will be a candlelight vigil at the Paw Paw park from 5:30pm-7:30pm for Domestic Violence. The Sheriffs office has received the approval for the annual vehicle replacement and there is a new Road Commissioner in the County named Wayne Nelson.**
- G. Road Commission- W.C. Askew reported that Bangor Township is on the new five year plan and over five million dollars will be used to repave county roads from 2025-2027. Dan Bishop is leaving his position for family reasons.**
