

ORDINANCE NO. 3

BANGOR TOWNSHIP
VAN BUREN COUNTY

An ordinance to regulate the speed of vessels and to provide for the safe use of the waters in Bangor Township, Van Buren County, enacted under the authority of Act 303, Public Acts of 1967, as amended (M.S.A. 18.1287 (1) being identical to State Administrative Rules filed in the Office of Secretary of State.

THE TOWNSHIP OF BANGOR, COUNTY OF VAN BUREN ORDAINS:

SECTION I

All words and phrases used in this ordinance shall be construed and have the same meanings as those words and phrases defined in Act 303, P.A. 1967, as amended, M.S.A. 18.1287 (8).

SECTION II

Regulation No. 80, Van Buren county.

R 281.780.7. Van Auken lake, Bangor township.

Rule 7. (1) On the waters of Van Auken lake, sections 28, 32, and 33, T2S, R16W, Bangor township, Van Buren county, it is unlawful, during the period of May 15 to September 15, between the hours of 6:30 p.m. and 10:00 a.m. of the following day, to:

- (a) Operate a vessel at high speed.
- (b) Have in tow, or otherwise assist in the propulsion of, a person on water skis, a water sled, kite, surfboard, or other similar contrivance.

(2) On the waters of the canals and channels connected to Van Auken lake, sections 28, 32, and 33, T2S, R16W, Bangor township, Van Buren county, it is unlawful for the operator of a vessel to exceed a slow--no wake speed.

SECTION III

All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed

SECTION IV

Violations of this ordinance are a misdemeanor and may be punished by a fine not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100) together with costs of prosecution or imprisonment in the county jail or such other place of detention as the court may prescribe, for period not to exceed ninety (90) days, or said fine, costs of prosecution, and imprisonment, at the discretion of the court.

SECTION V

This ordinance and the various parts, sections, subsections, provisions, sentences and clauses are severable. If any part of this ordinance is found to be unconstitutional or invalid it is declared the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected hereby.

SECTION VI

This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its publication in the BANGOR ADVANCE newspaper.

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE #3
REGULATING HOURS FOR HIGH-SPEED BOATING**

THE TOWNSHIP OF BANGOR, VAN BUREN COUNTY, MICHIGAN, HEREBY ORDAINS the following amendment to the Ordinance Regulating the speed of vessels and to provide for the safe use of the waters in Bangor Township, Van Buren County adopted by the Township of Bangor on March 8, 1977, as Ordinance #3:

The amended ordinance regulates the hours for operating a vessel at high speed under the authority of Act 303 of the Public Acts of 1967, as amended, being 281.1013 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

Section II, Rule 7 shall be amended to read:

- Rule 7. (1) On the waters of Van Auken Lake, sections 28, 32, and 33, T2S, R16W, Bangor Township, Van Buren County, it is unlawful, during the period of May 15 to September 15, between the hours of 6:30 pm and 10:00 am of the following day, to:
- (a) Operate a vessel at high speed
 - (b) Have in tow, or otherwise assist in the propulsion of, a person on water skis, a water sled, kite, surfboard or other similar contrivance
- (2) On the waters of the canals and channels connected to Van Auken Lake, Sections 28, 32, and 33, T2S, R16W, Bangor Township, Van Buren County, it is unlawful for the operator of a vessel to exceed a slow--no wake speed.


The hours shall be 7:30 pm to 11:00 am of the following day when Eastern Daylight Savings Time is in effect. "High-speed boating" is defined as a speed at or above which a motorboat reaches a planing condition.
