Fire Board- Derek Babcock reported that there were 17 calls with an average response time of just over 5 minutes for the month of August within Bangor Township that brings the year to date calls to 362. The Fire Board approved the purchase of an extractor to wash gear. Radio equipment will be reprogrammed soon to go with the new radio upgrades.**
- E. Pride Care- Steve Lowder reported 21 calls for the month of August with an average response time of 6:25 minutes. There were 14 priority one calls, 5 priority two calls, and 2 priority three calls.**
- F. County Commissioner- Mike Chappel reported the County Commissioners approved the resolution to create the Parks & Rec Commission. A resource deputy was approved for Hartford Public Schools. Cremation Permit Fees have been eliminated in Van Buren County. Road Commissioner Interviews took place on September 6th.**
- G. Supervisor- Mike Sullins reminds the Township of Tire collection on September 20th.**
