

**TOWNSHIP OF BANGOR  
COUNTY OF VAN BUREN, STATE OF MICHIGAN  
AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE #3  
REGULATING HOURS FOR HIGH-SPEED BOATING**

THE TOWNSHIP OF BANGOR, VAN BUREN COUNTY, MICHIGAN, HEREBY ORDAINS the following amendment to the Ordinance Regulating the speed of vessels and to provide for the safe use of the waters in Bangor Township, Van Buren County adopted by the Township of Bangor on March 8, 1977, as Ordinance #3:

The amended ordinance regulates the hours for operating a vessel at high speed under the authority of Act 303 of the Public Acts of 1967, as amended, being 281.1013 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

Section II, Rule 7 shall be amended to read:

Rule 7. (1) On the waters of Van Auken Lake, sections 28, 32, and 33, T2S, R16W, Bangor Township, Van Buren County, it is unlawful, during the period of May 15 to September 15, between the hours of 6:30 pm and 10:00 am of the following day, to:

(a) Operate a vessel at high speed

(b) Have in tow, or otherwise assist in the propulsion of, a person on water skis, a water sled, kite, surfboard or other similar contrivance

(2) On the waters of the canals and channels connected to Van Auken Lake, Sections 28, 32, and 33, T2S, R16W, Bangor Township, Van Buren County, it is unlawful for the operator of a vessel to exceed a slow--no wake speed.


The hours shall be 7:30 pm to 11:00 am of the following day when Eastern Daylight Savings Time is in effect. "High-speed boating" is defined as a speed at or above which a motorboat reaches a planing condition.
